Programme outline:

### **Cheshire East Council - Cat and Fiddle**

A project to reduce the disproportionately high number of motorcyclist casualties on the A537 'Cat & Fiddle'.

### **Derby & Derbyshire County Council - Integrated Motorcycle Problem Routes**

To use an innovative data system to analyse patterns of motorcycling and to target social marketing towards motorcyclists. The project will involve working closely with the motorcycling community in Derbyshire, with education, training, publicity and targeted enforcement activities.

### **Staffordshire County Council - Motorcycle Casualty Reduction**

To improve safety for motorcyclists by raising car driver awareness, tackling hazards such as diesel spills and mud on the road more effectively. Make minor highway engineering changes. Provide pre-rider education for 13-year-olds upwards and when motorcyclists are learning.

### **Warwickshire County Council - "Take Control" Motorcycle Training**

A programme to cover up to 1,300 powered two wheeler riders across the West Mercia area. The 'Take Control' motorcycle training enhances riders' abilities by targeting subsidised and accessible training towards riders at high risk of injury including riders who would have progressed from mopeds to 125cc bikes without additional training, new or inexperienced riders of high powered machines and riders motorcycling for leisure.

### **Transport for London - e-SUM (European Safer Urban Motorcycle Project) Update**

e-SUM is a collaborative initiative between industry and local authorities of Europe's principal motorcycle cities to identify, develop and demonstrate measures designed to deliver safer urban motorcycling in the short, medium and long term.

### **Driving Standards Agency (DSA)**

Update on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Driving Licence Directives.
